It is a great pleasure and honor for me to inform you that Prof. Dr. Bedford-Strohm, cofounder, member of the Advisory Board and supporter of IJOT has been elected on April 4th 2011 Bishop of the Evangelical-Lutheran Church in Bavaria, Germany (2,7 Million Members). May the Lord give him creative power, inspiration and enthusiasm for his ecumenical work for the unity of the Church!

I would also like to introduce you three new members of the Advisory Board: H. E. Archbishop Dr. Anastatios Yannoulatos, Archbishop of Tirana, Durres and all Albania expressed his willingness to contribute to the success of our international, open access journal. He is Primate and Head of the Holy Synod of the Autocephalous Orthodox Church of Albania, Prof. Dr. Dr. h.c.mult, Professor Emeritus of the National University of Athens, Honorary Member of the Academy of Athens and Honorary President of the World Conference of Religions for Peace.
